

## **Tunbridge Wells Chess Club Championship 2025\_2026**

This will be a seven round competition run as a 'Swiss'. The first round will be a random draw. Thereafter, so far as is possible, players will be paired against someone with the same cumulative score. Also so far as is possible each player's colour will alternate between black and white. No one will be paired against the same opponent twice.

The rounds will be played on the last Monday of each of October, November, January, February, March, April and the next to last Monday (18<sup>th</sup>) in May. If you are unable to come on any of these Mondays then you need to contact your opponent and arrange to play on a different day.

The time control will be all moves in one hour but with an increment of ten seconds per move.

The results will be submitted to the ECF (English Chess Federation) for grading. It is a requirement of entry that as well as being club members entrants must be ECF members at bronze level or above.
