This is an all-play-all competition in which each player plays each other player twice (once as black and once as white) in the course of the season. Each game lasts for a maximum of 30 minutes. The 30 minutes are divided according to players' grades as per the attached scheme. Players' September grades as published by the ECF will be used and will remain unchanged throughout the season. Players who do not have an official grade will be assigned an estimated grade by the club secretary.

There is no schedule. Games may be played by mutual arrangement on any Monday evening that the club is open. The committee would like to encourage club members to make the club quickplay the main thing that happens each first Monday of each month. It is recognized that not every possible game will be played. The winner will be the person with the highest number of points by 18th May. The quickplay knight will be awarded to the winner. Results will not be submitted for grading.
